Message from the Boathouse Committee



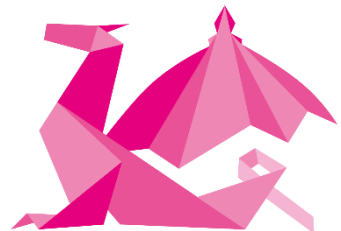
